UNICULTURE Methodological Framework

- EXECUTIVE SUMMARY -

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he Uniculture Project aims at developing knowledge and skills among academic teachers in a multicultural environment. The recipients of the project are academic teachers, however the beneficiaries are all the university members: from students and teachers, to the administrative staff. The results of the project will encourage more efficient academic work in every area, including research, in which the international students can be included with all their knowledge and experiences, to the social life, when they will become a part of the university community. The philosophy that underlies the outcomes of the Uniculture Project is not to teach the teachers, but to create a synergic methodology and a set of enabling tools, and joint knowledge developed in the academic world of information.

The course that will be developed as a part of the UniCulture project is based on the needs of academic teachers, as expressed in a needs analysis conducted within the project. It is also based on the following assumptions: it should be universal, accessible by any kind of academic teacher, and two-dimensional – basic knowledge and skills are always followed by references for deeper knowledge, modular, practical – with practical tips, cases and scenarios of workshops, open for sharing experiences and good practices, interactive, short and easy to implement, however its multidimensional structure makes it very rich in content.

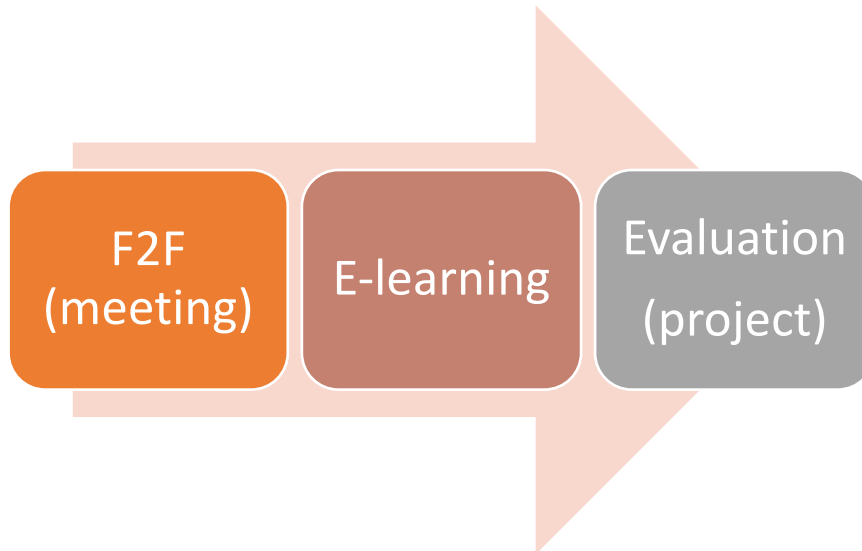
The package for teachers and trainers consists of four parts: the handbook – containing all theoretical knowledge, the workbook with practical implementation solutions fully related to the handbook, the manual for trainers, and the guide for communications – a short guide, mostly with infographics on how to communicate in a multicultural environment.

The content consists of four modules, divided into respective chapters:

1. Socio-cultural competences in multicultural and intercultural environments
2. Models for education
3. Theoretical Approaches and technologies of interaction with multicultural students
4. Social inclusion in universities.
